Why do we have rules and discipline policies? I believe it is because we want our children to develop into wise and loving people who value God and others. Luke 2:52 states, "and Jesus kept increasing in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men." Even as a twelve year old, Jesus grew up academically, physically, spiritually, and socially.

We are aiming to make wise choices this year. Here is how to do that:

Hand in your best work!Enter the room prepared to learn.Raise your hand to speak/leave seat.Obey rules and follow directions quickly.Exit the room leaving your area clean.Show respect to adults and peers.

Purple – Student went above and beyond, following in Jesus' footsteps. Student earns 5 extra coins

Dark Blue – Random acts of kindness and great classroom choices. Student earns 2 extra coins.

Light Blue – Random act of kindness. Student earns an extra coin.

Green – Good day! No discipline problems.

Yellow – After one warning. One discipline problem.

Five minutes off recess.

Orange – After two warnings. Two discipline problems.

Ten minutes off recess.

Red – Multiple problems. *Fifteen minutes off recess.*

Bold - Color, reason for getting to that color // Italics - Consequences
