Why do we have rules and discipline policies? I believe it is because we want our children to develop into wise and loving people who value God and others. Luke 2:52 states, "and Jesus kept increasing in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men." Even as a twelve year old, Jesus grew up academically, physically, spiritually, and socially.

We are aiming to make wise choices this year. Here is how to do that:

Hand in your best work!

Enter the room prepared to learn.

Raise your hand to speak/leave seat.

Obey rules and follow directions quickly.

Exit the room leaving your area clean.

Show respect to adults and peers.

**Purple – Student went above and beyond,  
following in Jesus’ footsteps.**  
*Student earns 5 extra coins*

**Dark Blue – Random acts of kindness  
and great classroom choices.**  
*Student earns 2 extra coins.*

**Light Blue – Random act of kindness.**  
*Student earns an extra coin.*

**Green – Good day!  
No discipline problems.**

**Yellow – After one warning.  
One discipline problem.**  
*Five minutes off recess.*

**Orange – After two warnings.  
Two discipline problems.**  
*Ten minutes off recess.*

**Red – Multiple problems.**  
*Fifteen minutes off recess.*

**Bold – Color, reason for getting to that color // Italics – Consequences**
