First Grade Syllabus 2016-2017

Subjects:

Bible - A study of Christian values through Scripture memory, Bible stories, and Christian traits

Language Arts - Phonics principles for basic reading skills and language principles for basic writing and communication skills are taught through phonics charts, flash cards, and application of sounds.

Reading consists of phonetic approach to teaching using sight words, oral reading, and comprehension.

Spelling is taught through weekly word lists that correlate with phonic lessons. Penmanship will review manuscript and letter formation using correct posture, grip, and neatness.

Composition includes creative writing.

Math - Traditional Arithmetic to teach children to count, add, subtract, tell time, measure, reason, and to pattern and sequence

Science - An overview of the senses, seasons and God's creations
Social Studies - An overview of freedoms, symbols, and people

Textbooks: A Beka, Bob Jones, and ACSI textbooks for the first grade
